A resolution from the Levelock Village Council Members supporting the Tribal Members of Levelock in our safety and well-being as the novel COVID-19 (Coronavirus) is worldwide and our concern with safety of our elders and tribal members, we hereby authorize Council Leadership to stop in village visits from non-residents until further notice. Essential work will continue and airlines can drop off supplies, groceries, etc. To Be effective as of 03/26/2020 at 5:00pm.

WHEREAS, Levelock Village Council is the governing body of Levelock and recognized as a Federally Recognized Tribe and has a responsibility to provide a government to protect the good health and welfare of its Tribal citizens and address an needs in its community; and

WHEREAS, Levelock Village Council is qualified to exercise powers of self-government and safety of the tribal members, by ways of its original Tribal sovereignty as passed down from its ancestors since time immemorial; and nothing in this resolution shall be conflict therewith; and

WHEREAS, there will be no loitering allowed in community buildings, limiting only to Assistant Administrator (April Apokedak) and Levelock Electric Cooperative Inc., Manager (Raymond Apokedak) to be upstairs of Levelock Village Council building; that if you need to do business/buy gas/oil/electricity, that you call beforehand, limiting to only 1 person at a time; and

WHEREAS, community members wishing to continue working for Levelock Village Council, may do so from home; and LVC employees recognize that there is a risk involved with working and do so by their own choice; and

WHEREAS, a written approval by Levelock Village Council is needed in order for any person to travel into Levelock; and

WHEREAS, a resident who recently came back or has recently came back as of 03/26/2020 must self-quarantine for a minimum of 14 days; and

WHEREAS, the Levelock Village Council will assume responsibility; And demonstrate self-reliance for our tribe in perpetuity to our land and people

WHEREAS, the Levelock Village Council is looking after the well-being of our community; and this is to protect the safety and well-being of our people through this pandemic, Thank You for your cooperation and understanding

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Levelock Village Council, a tribal government approves this Resolution for the safety of the Tribal Members and Elders to be approved on 03/26/2020 At the Village Council Emergency Special Meeting and by a vote of: YES_4_ and NO_0_ ABSENT _1_. Now that this be resolved and passed on 03/26/2020 in a Emergency Special Meeting. Held at Levelock Village Council Office.
