Naknek Native Village Council Resolution 2020-08 : In Summary

Members of the Naknek Native Village Council sincerely appreciate your cooperation and patience during these difficult times. Our sole objective of these new ordinances is to keep our Tribal & Community members safe, and to protect the integrity of the Native Village of Naknek & our surrounding Watershed Areas.

In Summary, Resolution 2020-08 has made these changes to Travel & Activities:

- We encourage a “Hunker-Down” Mentality. Try to Shelter-In-Place, Work from home if possible, and practice Social Distancing. Be diligent about hygiene and wash your hands often.
- Any & All Individuals who arrive into The Native Village of Naknek **MUST QUARANTINE**.
- For Local Residents: Avoid travel to Anchorage & the Lower 48 by all means. Unless there is a pressing Medical or Family Emergency, please **DO NOT TRAVEL**. Additionally, be respectful and avoid travel to surrounding Watershed Villages. By staying within your community, practicing Social Distancing, and not travelling to other communities, we can help prevent potential spread of COVID-19. This includes travel in any form (ATV, Aircraft, Boat, etc.).

Please be aware that if you leave The Native Village of Naknek, do not practice safe Social Distancing, or do not follow Mandatory Quarantine Guidelines, you are putting others at risk.

- For Non Residents: Due to recent developments of COVID-19 within the State of Alaska, all Non-essential Travel is banned until May 1st, 2020. Let's clarify Essential vs. Non Essential-

Essential Workers are hired by **TRIBAL, FEDERAL** or **STATE** owned Agencies, or are workers that required for **CRITICAL OPERATIONS**.

We understand that Peak Season is approaching. Please be compliant and cooperative with these Travel Restrictions. Travel Restrictions will be updated and amended no later than May 1st, 2020.
