


Flags and Buffs for Bristol Bay Fishermen

BBRSDA has ordered “Quebec” and “Lima” nautical flags and will be distributing these through processors to the Bristol Bay fleet (drift and setnetters) free of charge. The flags are expected to arrive in Bristol Bay in mid-to-late May. More information regarding distribution will be forthcoming.

“Quebec” flag: indicates vessel has completed quarantine.



“Lima” Flag: Indicates vessel is currently under quarantine.



State mandates and some local businesses are directing people to use a cloth facemask when traveling or when they are out in public where they may come into contact with other people. BBRSDA has ordered 8,000 buffs, which will be distributed to Bristol Bay commercial fishermen (free of charge) to support safety efforts and remind the fleet the only thing we want people to catch this year is high-quality salmon. These buffs are relatively inexpensive and are a great way to provide added protection against spreading or contracting the virus. Just remember to avoid touching the front of the buff after using in a public place and clean them regularly to maximize their effectiveness.
