

PBVC President Keith Jensen made the following announcement:

The State has advised that all non-essential out-of-state travel must cease, and that all other travelers must self-isolate for 14 days upon arrival.

Furthermore, the State has strongly advised that all non-essential in-state travel should cease, and any other travelers must self-isolate for 14 days upon arrival, especially to remote areas in Alaska where medical resources are limited.

In an effort to slow the spread of the virus, and to reduce the risk of exposure to COVID-19 here in Pedro Bay, the PBVC strongly advises that all non-essential travel to and from Pedro Bay must cease, and that all other travelers must self-isolate for 14 days upon arrival until further notice.

Residents should keep a physical distance of six feet from others at all times, and practice minimal contact with other residents.  
Do not make unnecessary visits to the PBVC offices.

Do not make unnecessary visits to the clinic, and if you feel you need to be seen, call first.
