### PILOT POINT RESIDENTS

THE PILOT POINT TRIBAL COUNCIL is concerned about the spread of COVID – 19 Virus within our community and region. Each of us must take steps and work together to ensure the health and safety of everyone in our village and do our part to help the region. Please follow the regional and state guidelines in order to protect all of us as much as possible.

- Practice social distancing – keep at least 6 feet away from each other when in public, even outside.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for 20 seconds, keep hands away from your face.
- Travel outside of the village should only be for emergencies or medical reasons. Follow guidelines for self – quarantine wherever you travel to.
- No non essential travel into the village. Example of essential travel would be an itinerant health aide or other medical staff authorized to travel.
- Anyone coming in to the village must self – quarantine for a minimum of 14 days. Family members that you live with are also required to self quarantine.
- The clinic doors are locked, if you need to be seen call the clinic and she will let you know when to come in. We have to give her time to do a screening over the phone and put on her protective gear if necessary before allowing anyone into the clinic. We have an Itinerant CHP here until April 8<sup>th</sup>. She is here to help us so make sure you do your part to keep her healthy as well. If there is no health aide BBAHC is directing resident to call the emergency room directly to receive instructions. The number to call is 1-800-478-5201 and ask for the ER.

We realize this is a stressful time for our community and region. Be assured we are keeping up with the news and especially all regional and state updates.

If there are any changes we need to make we will let you know. Please heed the warnings, this is not the time for a lot of social gathering, visiting, or hanging out, we need to all help to take care of each other.

If you or your household needs help, supplies, food etc. please call the office.
