

TOGIAK TRAVEL RECOMMENDATIONS

The Traditional Council of Togiak, Togiak Natives Ltd. and the City of Togiak have come together with one goal in mind.

Our goal is to reduce the entrance and spread of COVID-19 into the community.

EFFECTIVE: MARCH 25, 2020 AT 11:59PM

We will strongly discourage passenger transportation in and out of the village until May 1, 2020. Residents wishing to return home should do so immediately with a strongly recommended two-week quarantine upon return.

Local agencies will reevaluate the situation three weeks later on April 15, 2020.

Recommended exceptions:

1. Essential personnel for emergencies (i.e. electricity, water, or sewer repairs)
2. Essential medical travel and freight:
 - a. BBAHC will need to get important medical supplies in and out of Togiak,
 - b. patients will need to travel in and out of Togiak,
 - c. BBAHC medical providers will need to travel in and out of Togiak
3. Freight, cargo, and mail services.

Flight crews are asked to stay in aircraft if possible. However, they may conduct any necessary business required by their job or use the bathroom if needed. Local cargo handlers are discouraged from boarding the aircraft.
