Community of Clarks Point,

Do to the pandemic and possible spread of COVID-19, The Clarks Point Village Council is requiring the residents to follow some safety measures and guidelines. This is to ensure the safety of our elders, children, anyone with a weakened immune system or anyone with a medical condition, our community in general.

SAFETY MEASURES and GUIDELINES-

- A resident coming back from travel needs to Self-Quarantine for the next 14 days.
- Please put any non-emergency travel outside of our village on hold until further notice, per Governors mandates #11 and #12. The state has strongly advised all non-essential travel in-state to cease. All stores in Dillingham accept bush orders. Clarks Point Village Council has approved to schedule charters to bring groceries. Please contact the village council for dates and times of flights.
- Anyone currently not residing in Clarks Point is prohibited to enter the village of Clarks Point. Anyone wanting or needing to enter our village will need Clarks Point Village Council board member's approval before entering the community. The only persons able to travel per mandate #12 are health professionals and other emergency responders dispatched by the state or federal governments or BBAHC, Law enforcement personnel from the state or federal government and Pilots delivering freight and mail. This restriction is to anyone trying to travel by air, water or land.
- All residents should keep a physical distance of six feet from others at all times. Please practice minimal contact with other community members.

- Call before you go to the clinic. The health aide has been instructed to not let anyone in if they did not call ahead of time. Tuesday's is the only day she will see anyone for preventative care. All other days are for the sick. Of course, in the case of a health emergency contact her right away. Clinic number is 907-236-1232, Clinic cell number is 907-236-6040
- Residents are prohibited to travel out of Clarks Point unless medical or emergency as of April 22nd 2020.
- Only Bristol Bay residents are allowed to fish their sites in Clarks Point, AK. No one outside of the Bristol Bay region is allowed into the village for fishing or any other activity.
- Upon arrival, fisherman will need to abide by all mandates listed above. Set-netters will be asked to help the village monitor the beach for any trespassing (boat/skiff etc.) by non-resident.
- Noncompliance will result in fine of no less than \$10,000.00 or banishment from village.

All safety measures and guidelines are in effect until further notice. Clarks Point Village Council regrets the inconvenience this may cause. We would like to keep all of our community members safe from the coronavirus. Please contact us with any questions or concerns.
