## Clarks Point Travel Lockdown

Due to the increased risk of COVID-19 transmission due to travel, as there has been an increase in COVID-19 cases in nearby communities, as of October 15, 2020, Clarks Point is on lockdown.

There is to be no travel in or out of the village except for necessary medical travel and essential workers (healthcare workers, school district employees, necessary maintenance/repair workers, law enforcement, and other groups as approved by the Clarks Point Village Council.)

If you were already on travel status when this lockdown was enacted, please contact the Tribal President or a CLPVC staff member.

Clarks Point Residents who need to travel out due to medical appointments need to contact the Tribal President or a Clarks Point Village Council employee prior. If the resident who travels for medical stays overnight (with the exception of inpatient care at the hospital) they must quarantine upon their return for 14 days.

This lockdown will remain in effect until reversed by the Clarks Point Village Council.
