### TRIBAL MANDATE (TRAVEL/COVID-19 Response)

On **September 30, 2020**, the Clarks Point Village Council unanimously passed a motion to amend and update the previous travel/COVID-19 mandate in response to the increased risk to the Clarks Point community due to active COVID-19 cases and community spread in nearby communities.

Effective immediately, the below travel and COVID-19 response mandate shall supersede all previous travel mandates for the community of Clarks Point and shall remain in effect until revoked or amended by the Clarks Point Village Council. This mandate is enforced by Tribal Law. Noncompliance will result in a fine of \$10,000 at minimum and may lead up to banishment from the village. Community members who do not follow the mandate may lose eligibility for future Clarks Point Village Council assistance programs.

Residents are strongly encouraged to avoid all non-essential travel. All three grocery stores are currently processing phone orders and there is a grocery charter that comes to Clarks Point weekly (at no cost to residents).

Community members are strongly encouraged to practice excellent social distancing and maintain at least 6 feet of distance between themselves and those who are not within their household at all times.

### Clarks Point Resident Travel

#### Day Travel in Bristol Bay Region (No Overnight)

- Residents who travel within the Bristol Bay Region and do not overnight in another community are not required to quarantine upon return; their household is also under quarantine for 14 days.

#### Overnight Travel in Bristol Bay Region or Travel Outside of Region

- Residents who stay in another community overnight for any reason or those who leave the Bristol Bay Region must quarantine at home for 14 days; their household is also under quarantine for 14 days.

#### Travel Safety Procedures

Residents are required to comply with the following items while travelling:

- Wear a mask.
- Maintain at least 6 feet of distance from those outside of their immediate household whenever possible.
- Utilize excellent hygiene practices (hand washing/hand sanitizer).

### Non-Resident Travel into Clarks Point

**Those who do not reside in the Village (with the exception of essential workers) may not enter the community of Clarks Point without prior approval by the Clarks Point Village Council.**

#### Approval process:

Visitors must contact a Clarks Point Village Council employee (outlined below) prior to travel (the employee will contact the Tribal President or Tribal President's Designee for approval) and wait for approval.

Non-residents will be required to quarantine for 14 days, if they stay with a local household, that household must also quarantine for 14 days.

### Quarantine Requirements:

- No visitors
- No visiting other homes/households (other than the household they are staying with).
- No entering businesses, entities, or organizations. (school, CLPVC, post office...etc.).

#### \*Essential Workers\*

Healthcare workers, school district employees, law enforcement, necessary maintenance/repairs workers...or other groups as approved by the Clarks Point Village Council.
