**EMERGENCY PUBLIC NOTICE!!**

**To the residents of Twin Hills and local air carriers:**

Due to the recent report of a positive case involving COVID-19, the Twin Hills Village Council strongly discourages social gatherings between households. We are expecting a team from BBAHC to arrive weather permitting Tuesday December 8, 2020. We encourage all to be tested so we can have a better idea if this is community wide spread. All household members and contacts have been directed to quarantine until after testing and results come back. This may take a week or longer due to the labs being overwhelmed with COVID 19 testing throughout the State of Alaska.

Twin Hills Village Council office is closed to the Public until further notice. Only 1 or 2 designated employees are allowed to work in the office at this time only for the Cares Act Grant due to the deadline coming up fast.

No one is allowed to leave the village unless it is a medical emergency or already pre-scheduled medical appointment until further notice. If airlines have any questions they are to call John Sharp, President at 907-493-2521. Only people allowed to fly into Twin Hills at this time are local residents, essential travelers, (State Troopers, OCS, BBAHC Staff, SWRSD Maintenance Crew) and must show proof of COVID-19 test completed wherever testing is available. BBAHC? CAPSTONE? Anchorage airport? **Any village resident that is returning to Twin Hills is required to quarantine or isolate with all household members for 14 days.**



Twin Hills residents at this time are not allowed to go shopping at Togiak. AC Togiak and Togiak CO-OP will take phone orders. Twin Hills Village Council will get 1 or 2 designated people to pick up groceries at certain date and time of the week. Once a week. If anything we may even have to have a local airline fly in ordered groceries/supplies. Anything out of this schedule will be own persons responsibility to get your stuff in.

We encourage ELDERS and HIGH RISK individuals to stay home as much as possible. Have someone do errands for you.

Sanitize, disinfect, and practice good hygiene. Wash your hands, disinfect surfaces, and avoid touching your face as much as possible.



Post Office will call people who have mail to pick up through the back door at this time. The front door is locked until further notice.

Twin Hills Village Council will reassess after COVID-19 testing results have been verified by BBAHC and schedule a telephonic meeting with other local and neighboring entities.

Twin Hills Village Council Local Essential workers are required to wear a mask at all times when entering public facilities and maintain 6 foot distancing.
