**PUBLIC NOTICE!!  
January 15, 2021**

**To the residents of Twin Hills and local air carriers:**

Due to the recent reports of positive cases involving COVID-19 in the neighboring village, the Twin Hills Village Council strongly discourages social gatherings between households. Testing completed December 9, 2020 had no positive to date.

Twin Hills Village Council Office continues to remain closed to the Public until further notice. Only designated employees are allowed to work in the office at this time.

Residents are discouraged to leave the village unless it is a medical emergency or already pre-scheduled medical appointment until further notice. If airlines have any questions they are to call John Sharp, President at 907-493-2521. Only people allowed to fly into Twin Hills at this time are local residents, essential travelers, (State Troopers, OCS, BBAHC Staff, SWRSD Maintenance Crew etc..) and must show proof of COVID-19 test completed and negative wherever testing is available. BBAHC? CAPSTONE? Anchorage airport? **Any village resident that is returning to Twin Hills outside of the Dillingham Census area is required to quarantine or isolate with all household members for 14 days.**

If you need to go shopping at Togiak please be aware that only one person from a house is allowed to shop at this time. (MASK UP) Please adhere to the rules of the stores due to the rise in positive COVID cases at Togiak. AC Togiak and Togiak CO-OP will take phone orders.

We encourage ELDERS and HIGH RISK individuals to stay home as much as possible. Have someone do errands for you.


Sanitize, disinfect, and practice good hygiene. Wash your hands, disinfect surfaces, and avoid touching your face as much as possible.
