SUBJECT: Summer Safety COVID-19 Mitigation Mandate (Residents & Non-Residents)

**AMENDED 4/22/2021**

The Clarks Point community has been incredibly blessed so far to avoid any cases of COVID-19 in the community. It is hoped that through the continued mitigation efforts outlined below to continue to protect the community/visitors from COVID-19 and to decrease the chances of COVID-19 spreading during the busy summer season. As there are still a lot of unknown factors with regards to COVID-19 spreading we strongly encourage both vaccinated and unvaccinated persons to complete asymptomatic testing when available and for those who experience symptoms consistent with COVID-19 to stay home and contact a medical professional (regardless of their vaccination status) as vaccines are not 100% effective.

CLPVC recognizes that in the summer it is necessary for non-residents to travel to Clarks Point for fishing and/or subsistence activities. The below safety mitigation plan it thus implemented for all residents and all summer visitors. Please keep in mind that the mitigation plan may be revised or become more restrictive if there are local cases or other areas of concerns due to COVID-19.

**Clarks Point will be open to non-residents on May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021, and the changes outlined in the mandate will also take effect May 1, 2021.**

Please become familiar with the 2021 Summer Safety COVID-19 Mitigation Mandate for Clarks Point; especially if you are entering/re-entering the community.

# **Summer Safety COVID-19 Mitigation Mandate (Residents & Non-Residents)**

**Clarks Point will be open to Non-Residents for the summer fishing season on May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 and the mandate as outlined below will take effect May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021.**

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## **Travel into Clarks Point/Returning to Clarks Point**

### **Vaccinated/Recovered from COVID-19 Within 90 Days**

Adults/Youth that are 16-17 years of age that are fully vaccinated (14 days after your 2<sup>nd</sup> vaccine or 14 days from your 1<sup>st</sup> vaccine for Johnson/Johnson) or have been diagnosed and recovered from COVID-19 within the last 90 days; are **not** required to quarantine upon arrival in Clarks Point upon providing documentation of your vaccination status or recovery from COVID-19. Those who do not opt to provide documentation of vaccination/recovery will be required to quarantine as outlined below.

**\*If you intend or may travel to Clarks Point this summer, please consider providing documentation of your vaccination status or documentation of recovery prior to arrival to make the process smoother and the Administrator will keep it on file for the summer. Your vaccination/recovery status is confidential and will remain only with CLPVC. You can scan/email copies of your documentation to [Tribaladministrator@clpvc.org](mailto:Tribaladministrator@clpvc.org), text it to (907)843-2837 or provide it directly to on-site staff. The office is closed to the public due to the COVID-19 pandemic, but our staff will be at the office from 11am-3pm in the summer and can meet you outside of the building to accept your documentation.**

### **Non-Vaccinated/Not Fully Vaccinated/ Not Recovered from COVID-19 Within 90 Days**

If you are over the age of 16 and not fully vaccinated (less than 14 days after your 2<sup>nd</sup> vaccine or less than 14 days from your 1<sup>st</sup> vaccine for Johnson/Johnson) or have not had/recovered from COVID-19 within the last 90 then you must quarantine for 10 days, with the voluntary option to end quarantine at 7 days with a negative COVID-19 test result for a test at your own expense completed on the 7<sup>th</sup> day.

**We are anticipating a COVID-19 machine for our community, but currently do not have the ability to provide COVID-19 testing in Clarks Point.**

Please continue to monitor yourself for COVID-19 symptoms, especially within 14 days of travel regardless of your vaccination status as vaccines are not perfect; and though the chances are greatly decreased by vaccination or recovery from infection it is still possible to contract and spread COVID-19. If you or a household member exhibit any symptoms with COVID-19, please follow the **“Experiencing COVID-19”** section below.

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## **Masks/Social Distancing**

Masks are **required** when entering the Post Office, School, or any other business communal area.

Community members and visitors are highly encouraged to wear a mask when near others outside of their households, to practice social distancing by maintaining a distance of at least 6 feet and avoid gatherings especially indoors.

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## **Essential Workers**

Essential workers who are travelling to Clarks Point for work purposes or returning to Clarks Point after leaving for work purposes may immediately return to work if their tasks are necessary and if safety mitigation can be observed, such as but not limited to: working outside whenever possible, working alone whenever possible, wearing a mask, avoiding gatherings, and any other reasonable safety mitigation factor imposed by the employer.

Essential workers include but are not limited to hospital staff, school staff, law enforcement, maintenance workers, electricians travelling to Clarks Point for necessary tasks. If you are not sure if you are considered an essential worker, please contact the Tribal Administrator prior to travel.

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### **While Under Quarantine:**

#### **Do:**

- Enjoy outside activities while observing proper social distancing measures.
- Go fishing/complete subsistence activities with those from your household/crew.

#### **Do Not:**

- Enter any other household or business.
- Closely interact with any other household (observe 6 feet of distance whenever possible and wear a mask).

Those who do not comply with the mandate may be subject to the following disciplinary actions:  
Step #1: Warning, Step #2: \$500 fine, Step #3: \$1000 fine and loss of additional services provided through CLPVC.

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## **Experiencing Symptoms of COVID-19**

If you or someone in your household or on your crew is experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, stay home/on your vessel and contact the Clarks Point Clinic at (907)236-1232 (during regular hours) or (907)236-6040 (emergency/after hours lines) or Bristol Bay Area Health Corporation (BBAHC) at (907)842-5201 and get further instruction from a medical professional. Currently, Clarks Point does not have a local testing machine and relies heavily on BBAHC for assistance.
