
COVID-19 PROTOCOLS FOR THE VILLAGE OF TOGIAK

The Traditional Council of Togiak has formed a working group for the community to enforce safety guidelines during this global pandemic.


- Unnecessary travel is discouraged at this time - if it is not a medical or family emergency.
- Non-residents and essential workers are encouraged to follow protocols set forth by the Village of Togiak.
- People coming into the village of Togiak are **HIGHLY RECOMMENDED** to follow the 7 – 10 day self-quarantine State recommendation – with the exception of essential workers. Fully vaccinated people are still encouraged to quarantine for 10 days if you are NOT having any symptoms; Or - quarantine for 7 days with no symptoms AND have a negative COVID test. If the COVID test comes out as positive, then it is recommended that you isolate yourself and quarantine for the full 14 days.
- **If you or a household member test positive, the residence which you are quarantined or isolated in, ALL HOUSEHOLD MEMBERS are URGED to quarantine or isolate as well.**
- If you are under quarantine or isolation orders, continue to practice social distancing – NO visitors, NO going out to public establishments unless it's a medical emergency, and if you must – practice social distancing and mask wear.
- **It is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED for all tribal members to utilize a face covering IN ALL PUBLIC ESTABLISHMENTS and continue to practice social distancing.**
- It is MANDATORY for Traditional Council of Togiak (TCT) employees to utilize a mask when interacting with clients, and while in public establishments during office hours.
- TCT office doors MAY REMAIN LOCKED. Call the office prior to stopping by the office – scheduling appointments are encouraged.

- TCT encourages every community member 18 years of age and older; especially elders and high-risk individuals, to get vaccinated.

- To schedule a vaccination, you can call the Togiak Clinic at 493 – 5511.
- If there is a confirmed positive case in Togiak, BBAHC will notify TCT in accordance with HIPAA regulations. TCT will follow Bristol Bay Area Health Corporation protocol should there be a confirmed positive case in the village.
- We **ENCOURAGE ELDERS & HIGH-RISK INDIVIDUALS TO STAY HOME** as much as possible. Have someone do errands for you.
- If you or your family member(s) are feeling sick, or have symptoms of the virus we urge you to **STAY HOME** and get tested as soon as possible.
- Continue to **SANITIZE, DISINFECT, AND PRACTICE GOOD HYGIENE**. Wash your hands, disinfect surfaces in your home, and avoid touching your face as much as possible.
- TCT will be adhering to the Bristol Bay Native Association sanitation policy. This will include tribal employees sanitizing and wiping down surfaces after seeing each client(s).
- TCT will continue to maintain a visitation log each time anyone enters the tribal offices, for contact tracing purposes.
- Parents and/or Guardians are encouraged to continue to educate children about the COVID-19 virus on how it can affect everyone in the community, and how important it is to practice social distancing and stay home.
- We encourage tribal members to follow all Southwest Region School District (SWRSD) and Bristol Bay Area Health Corporation (BBAHC) policies and protocols.
- We encourage parents to have your children home at the established curfew hours (10 PM Sunday to Friday, 11 PM Friday & Saturday). Curfew violators are to be reported to City of Togiak VPO or Tribal Court. The Tribal Court will require a petition to be filed.
- We encourage the tribal members to attend any and all meetings regarding tribal business via posted teleconference numbers.
