CHIGNIK BAY TRIBAL COUNCIL COVID-19 Travel MANDATE

The Chignik Bay Tribal Council has set mandates in an effort to prevent the spread of COVID-19 within our community.

The following mandates are for everyone coming in and out of Chignik Bay.

TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS:

- Prior to coming to Chignik Bay please notify the Chignik Bay Tribal Council or the City of Chignik of your date of arrival.
- Essential and Non-Essential Travelers coming into Chignik Bay must be tested negative within 72 hrs prior to arrival.
- If you choose NOT to test, you are required to quarantine for the full 14 days from your time of arrival.
- Upon a negative test result, people who are fully vaccinated (meaning at least 2 weeks has past since your second dose of Pfizer/Moderna or 2 weeks past since 1 doze of Johnson and Johnson vaccine,) If you are fully vaccinated then upon arrival you will still have to quarantine for full 5 days (village may require proof of vaccination).
- People who are NOT fully vaccinated who have traveled need to quarantine along with their household for at least 14 days upon arriving in the village.
- People who are fully vaccinated can gather indoors with other people who are fully vaccinated without wearing a mask, (unvaccinated children may gather with vaccinated family pods at the discretion of the parents)
- Per CDC guidelines it is still recommended to take precautions in public settings by wearing a mask and maintaining 6 feet distance.
- Inner village travel is open if person is going by skiff or boat only between Chignik Lake, Chignik Lagoon.
- **Ignoring or violating this mandate can result in removal of services provided by the Chignik Bay Tribal Council.**
