To: All ATC Employees and Council Members Re: Updated Plan for COVID-19 Pandemic

Date: Thursday, August 19, 2021

The Aleknagik Traditional Council will take the following precautions for the COVID-19 virus within the workplace and the community of Aleknagik.

Office Closures to the Public

- 1. The Aleknagik Traditional Council employees will allow limited access for Aleknagik residents and building access will be by appointment only. Anyone entering the building must have their temperature checked and use a face mask. No public use of the restrooms or loitering will be allowed. Employees must wash hands frequently.
- 2. If any employee, council member, or members of the public feel sick they must have a negative COVID-19 test before coming back to work or entering the building.
- The Aleknagik Native Store building area will open with the door closed to the office and meeting area.

If you have traveled outside of the region:

- 1. Staff and council members must notify the Aleknagik Traditional Council if they or a household family member have traveled outside the region.
- Staff and council members who have not been vaccinated MUST quarantine for 10 days before entering the building and have a negative COVID-19 test. Fully vaccinated (two weeks after 2nd dose of Moderna or Pfizer or 2 weeks after the Johnson & Johnson single dose) staff and council members may return to work without quarantining with a negative COVID-19 test.
- 3. Limit contact with everyone and practice social distancing- stay 6 to 12 feet away from other people.

*CDC Updated Information for Travelers 4/2/21 Fully vaccinated travelers are less likely to get and spread COVID-19.

- People who are fully vaccinated with an FDA-authorized vaccine can travel safely within the United States:
 - a. Fully vaccinated travelers do not need to get tested before or after travel unless their destination requires it
 - b. Fully vaccinated travelers do not need to self-quarantine
 - Fully vaccinated travelers should still follow CDC's recommendations for traveling safely including:
 - a. Wear a mask over your nose and mouthb. Stay 6 feet from others and avoid crowds

 - c. Wash your hands often or use hand sanitizer

If you have been exposed to the COVID-19:

- 1. For unvaccinated staff and council members: 14 day at home quarantine with pay and must have a negative COVID-19 test before returning to work.
- 2. For fully vaccinated staff and council members: 7 to 10 days quarantine with pay without testing, after 3 to 5 days of exposure employees must have a negative COVID-19 test before returning to work.
- 3. Work from home will be allowed if possible.

If there are positive cases of COVID-19 in Aleknagik:

- All doors to the Public will locked, the store will be closed, the transit van will cease, and drop boxes will be made
- Work from home will be allowed if possible.
