UPDATED MANDATE **August 10, 2021**

New Stuyahok is currently on lockdown until further notice, masks must be worn at all times.

Any sign of fever, cough or symptoms are required to be tested immediately

This is for the health, and safety for our community of New Stuyahok. Please take this seriously for the well-being of our elders, disabled, people with medical issues, children and anyone with immune problems.

SOCIAL GATHERING: During lockdown there will be no Social gathering in all public places also no visiting family, relatives and friends, no mingling with friends within the community until further notice.

CLOSE CONTACT: Close contact(the people who have been around a positive person) they will need to get tested and quarantine, if the close contact person(s) are unable to isolate within their homes then the whole household need to quarantine for the full 10 days, the includes both vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals.

PROHIBITION: All travel into New Stuyahok Village by persons not engaged in essential services is prohibited. This applies to travel from other villages as well as from regional centers, anchorage, out of state, and to all forms of transportation including air travel, snow machine, and other ground or water transportation, any travel questions please contact the tribe.

No travel between villages is permitted until further notice.

ESSENTIAL TRAVEL: Persons engaged in essential travel services are:

- Health professionals and other emergency responders dispatched by the state of Alaska or federal governments or the Bristol Bay Area Health Corporation.
- Law enforcement personnel from the state of federal government.
- Pilots and other air carrier personnel delivering freight and mail, or transporting passengers engaged in essential services.
- Contact the tribe before traveling to the village.

EXCEPTIONS: The prohibition on travel in this ordinance does not apply to:

- Residents of the Village who traveled for medical purposes for themselves or a close relative, upon returning to the village when their treatment is concluded, provided that they have certification from a doctor that they have been tested and are not effected with COVID19 Virus.
- Contact the tribe before traveling to the village.

THE NEW STUYAHOK TRADITIONAL COUNCIL CREATED THIS MANDATE FOR THE HEALTH AND SAFETY FOR ALL RESIDENTS IN THE VILLAGE OF NEW STUYAHOK.
