

CHIGNIK BAY TRAVEL MANDATE

Effective October 7, 2021 the Chignik Bay Emergency Operation Committee has revised travel mandates in an effort to prevent the spread of COVID-19 within our community.

TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS:

- Prior to coming to Chignik Bay please notify the Chignik Bay Tribal Council or the City of Chignik of your date of arrival.
- Essential and Non-Essential Travelers coming into Chignik Bay are asked to be tested negative within 72 hrs prior to arrival.
- If you choose NOT to test, you are required to quarantine along with your household for the full 14 days from your time of arrival whether or not they or you are fully vaccinated.
- Upon a Negative test result, people who are fully vaccinated (meaning at least 2 weeks has passed since second dose of Phizer/Moderna; or 2 weeks passed since 1 doze of Johnson and Johnson vaccine) you must still quarantine along with your household for 5 days. If you have symptoms within the 5 days please call the clinic for an appointment to be tested.
- People who are NOT fully vaccinated who have traveled need to quarantine along with their household for the full 14 days upon arriving in the village.
- People who ARE fully vaccinated can gather indoors with other people who are fully vaccinated without wearing a mask, (unvaccinated children may gather with vaccinated family pods at the discretion of the parents).
People who chose not to disclose whether they are vaccinated will be assumed to be NON-vaccinated and will have to quarantine for the full 14 days along with their household.
People who are NOT fully vaccinated must wear a mask and social distance when gathering indoors with other people.
- Per CDC guidelines it is still recommended to take precautions in public settings by wearing a mask and maintaining 6 feet distance.
- Inner village travel is open for fully vaccinated people traveling from Chignik Lake, Chignik Lagoon and Perryville only if there are no known cases.
