Ordinance 2021-09-08

ORDINANCE TO PLACE RESTRICTIONS ON TRAVEL DUE TO COVID-19

(Supersedes ordinance 2020-03-30)

As of September 14, 2021

Chignik Lagoon Village Council has approved the following updates to the COVID-19 Travel Ban Ordinance. We appreciate everyone (residents and non-residents) to follow the below guidelines to help prevent or spread the Covid-19 virus and to keep our village safe.

- At least 72 hours prior to flying into the village, please notify the Covid Coordinator or the village office of your travels
- Adults and children who are traveling into Chignik Lagoon need to have a negative Covid-19 test within 72 hours of planned travel or quarantine for 14 days in a pre-determined resident
- If everyone in your household whom you are traveling with are fully vaccinated and each of you have a negative covid-19 test, no need to quarantine unless experiencing symptoms. (If you are not able to test prior to departing from your destination, you may test at the clinic when you return but you will need to quarantine until you test and receive results.)
- If you or someone in your household whom you are traveling with are not fully vaccinated, then your household needs to have a negative covid test prior to coming into the village. Quarantine for 7 days. On day 7, everyone who is unvaccinated needs another negative covid-19 test and if no one is experiencing any covid-19 symptoms, quarantine is no longer necessary.
- If you or all your household does not want to get a covid-19 test, your household will need to quarantine for 14 days.
- Inner village travel is open if person is going by skiff or boat only between Chignik Lake or Chignik Bay

This ordinance will be updated on a quarterly or as needed basis.
