FEDERAL SUBSISTENCE NOTICE 2022 Federal Caribou Hunt Unit 9E



The manager of Alaska Peninsula and Becharof National Wildlife Refuges, as the Federal in-season manager, has announced a Federal subsistence caribou hunt for unit 9E. The announced split season will be open from Aug. 10 – Oct. 10, 2022 and Nov. 1 – Apr. 30, 2023 for 9E.

WHO CAN APPLY: Only residents of unit 9E, Nelson Lagoon, and Sand Point.

HOW TO APPLY: Eligible hunters may apply for a permit by telephone or in person (see contact information below).

For unit 9E, **only** federally qualified subsistence users from unit 9E, Nelson Lagoon, and Sand Point with a valid State Tier II (TC 505) permit or a valid Federal permit may harvest **1 bull caribou** on Federal lands within unit 9E.

Hunters may not add the harvest limit from Federal Subsistence and State Tier II hunt regulations together to increase the harvest total.
