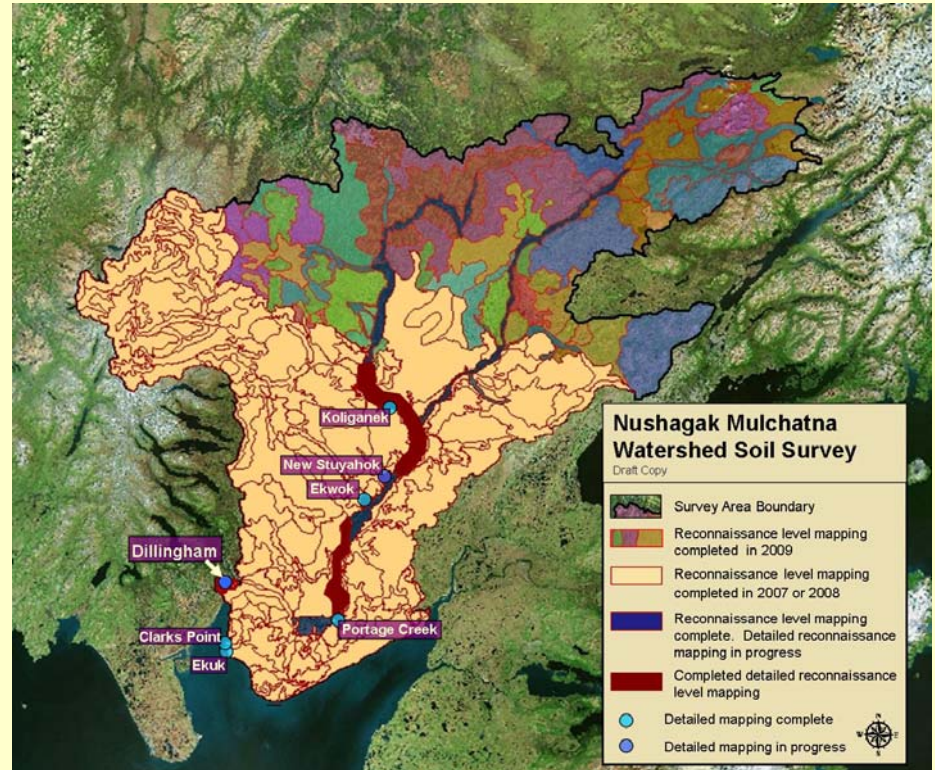


Nushagak-Mulchatna Soil Survey

The USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) and the Nushagak-Mulchatna Watershed Council entered into a partnership to produce soil survey coverage for the Nushagak-Mulchatna Watershed. Field work was completed in 2011 and the final soil survey to made available after 2012.

- ❑ A soil survey produces maps and descriptions of the soil landscape – key tor understanding and working effectively with hydrology, engineering, habitat, and ecology.
- ❑ Communities mapped at detailed level (1:25,000) and include: Koliganek, New Stuyahok, Ekwok, Portage Creek, Dillingham, Aleknagik, Clarks Point, and EkuK.
- ❑ River corridors mapped at 1:63,000 and the remaining area (northern half of the watershed) at 1:500,000.
- ❑ The NM Watershed Soil Survey a big step toward full soil coverage of Alaska accounting for 8.3 million acres.
